The Dual Fellowship Program of the Hong Kong College of Health Service Executives (HKCHSE) and the Australasian College of Health Service Management (ACHSM) is conducted through an immersion training mode to capacitate the candidates to take on their healthcare service background and learn to thrive through the journey of developing their management competency in healthcare service. With the teaching panel consisting both the Fellows of the HKCHSE and experienced executives and experts of the various trades of healthcare, the Program also provides opportunities for exposure to diverse experiences of both the local and regional context of health services management.

### The criteria of admission include eligibility for membership as a Dual Associate Fellow of the HKCHSE and the ACHSM :

#### • Managerial role

- (a) performing managerial roles in a healthcare-related field; and
- (b) having been in a health service management position for at least two years or a full-time health management academic position for at least one year; and

#### • Academic qualifications

- (a) obtained a Master's degree or equivalent post-graduate training; and
- (b) possessing academic qualifications in health service management or another management field; and

#### • Work experience

- having at least five years of clinical or healthcare-related work experience; and

#### • May be invited to attend an interview
