

Diploma in Advances in Medicine 2026 – 2027

11 January 2026 – 31 December 2027

Introduction

Advancements in medical management of diseases are being made at a remarkable pace. In order to benefit from them, doctors need to be constantly updated. This enhances their skill in caring for their patients. At the same time, many changes are taking place in different healthcare perspectives. Patients are better informed and have higher expectation. The general public has greater demand on the medical professionals. In response to this evolving medical dynamics, medical institutes have developed more regulatory requirements. This two-year Diploma programme in Advances in Medicine is an opportunity to achieve some of these goals. Through the programme, we will not only share the latest medical knowledge and state of art management, but will also establish the network sharing health responsibilities among the general public, patients, family doctors and specialists. In addition to exhibiting therapy for diseases, we will be moving towards preventive medicine and health enhancing management.

Admission Requirement

Candidates must have a Medical Science related degree or equivalent qualification.

Programme Design

The Diploma programme will commence on 11 January 2026 and be completed on 31 December 2027.

- A 2-year diploma programme
- 24 sessions on Sunday afternoons from 1:00 – 7:00p.m.
- Each session will address 3 topics through lecture and interactive case discussion.
- Teaching format of each topic will be:

• Lecture	1 hour
• Interactive case study	45 minutes (0.75 hour)
• Self-learning • Journal reading assigned by the lecturer in charge	3.5 hours
<i>Total teaching and learning hours for each session</i>	<i>15.75 hours</i>
Total teaching and learning hours for the Diploma are 378 hours.	

Requirements for Awarding the Diploma

- Diploma will be awarded to candidates who have attended AT LEAST 75% of the 2-year programme AND successfully passed the programme assessment at the end of BOTH year 1 and year 2.
- Attendance of individual session will acquire CME, CNE and CPD of the session.
- Diploma will be awarded to Day Registration participants if their accumulated participation in particular year achieves 75% of the total attendance and pass the examination(s) as required by the respective programme of study.
