



A Guide to application as a Fellow of the College of Pharmacy Practice

To become a Fellow of the College of Pharmacy Practice(CPP), the pharmacist must be a member of the College of Pharmacy Practice and in practice for at least 10 years in addition to meeting the criteria for recognition as a specialist in Hong Kong or other countries. He/she could also be elected to CPP Fellow by meeting one or more of the following metrics of excellence:

- a. Distinguished contribution to the advancement of the pharmacy profession (e.g. distinguished and sustained accomplishments as an educator or distinguished and sustained service to the College and/or other pharmaceutical societies, associations, and organizations),
- b. Outstanding technical management and leadership,
- c. A distinguished record of significant publications of impact.

The applicant must complete the application form and provide a short personal statement of his/her accomplishments supported by a bibliography, if pertinent, with description for meeting the above criteria. In addition, the applicant must obtain the nomination and support from two Fellows of the College or at least one of the Fellows of the College and support from his or her current or previous supervisor(s) and lodged in the application and prescribed fees together with all the required documentations.
