



A Guide to application as a Fellow of the College of Pharmacy Practice

To become a Fellow of the College of Pharmacy Practice(CPP), the pharmacist must be in practice for at least 10 years and a member of the College of Pharmacy Practice. He/she could be elected to CPP Fellow by meeting one or more of the following metrics of excellence:

- a. Excellence in pharmacy practice, research and education in specialty area(s), where the applicant is recognized as a specialist in Hong Kong or other countries, for an extended period of time;
- b. Distinguished contribution to the advancement of the pharmacy profession for an extended period of time (e.g. significant advancement of the practice of pharmacy; distinguished and sustained service to the College);
- c. Outstanding technical management and leadership for an extended period of time;
- d. A distinguished record of significant publications of impact.

Please note: Extended period of time is considered to be 10 years or more.

The applicant must complete the application form and provide a short personal statement of his/her accomplishments supported by a bibliography, if pertinent, with description for meeting the above criteria. In addition, the applicant must obtain the nomination and support from two Fellows of the College or at least one of the Fellows of the College and support from his or her current or previous supervisor(s) and lodged in the application and prescribed fees together with all the required documentations.
